

Granted projects kick off

April October

Traffic Light Reporting (TLR)

- Biannual reporting
- September to February

Midterm reporting

- Depending on a project start date covers 18M
- Evaluation of project progress by funding agencies

2025 June

Knowledge Sharing Workshop

Workshop promoting projects results.

2025 August

End of term

Final reporting due 60 days after the conclusion



2. General principles for monitoring and agreements

Granted projects sign the commitment at three different levels:

1. Joint Call granted project level

- Consortium agreement between partners

2. Transnational Joint Call level

- Implementation Commitment

3. National level of each participating country

- National Grant Agreement between the National Funding Agency of that country and the participants from that same country in the Joint Call-granted project

2. General principles for monitoring and agreements

Granted projects obligations:

1. Traffic light reports

- September October
- March-August
- TLR 1 all projects cover the first reporting

2. Mid-term review

• Granted Projects must prepare a mid-term review report, followed by a mid-term review meeting.

3. Final report:

Projects will be obliged to submit a final report

4. Workshops:

- Attending knowledge-sharing workshops
- Promotion of projects on an international level

3. Responsibilities of the partners in Joint Call-granted projects

- Joint Call-granted projects teams:
 - Delivering the assigned tasks and knowledge sharing, where relevant, through participation in Joint Call Network Workshops.
- Main Coordinators of Joint Call-Granted Projects
 - Responsible for ensuring that the projects deliver what is stated in the grant agreements and the project proposals.
- Country Coordinator
 - responsible for national reporting following national rules
 - Financial and progress reporting as per the national grant agreement
 - Contact point for a country
- Amendments
 - Requested and administrated by the Joint Call Secretariat and the relevant Funding agencies/Agencies
 - Template will be provided



4. Kick-off meetings

- All projects organise a kick-off meeting
 - Joint Call Partners at the Funding Agency level from the Main Coordinators' country should participate
 - Joint Call Partners at the Funding Agency level from other participating countries should be invited.
 - From the Joint Call-granted project side, at least the Coordinator, Country Coordinators, and Work Package leaders should be present.
- The kick-off should be organised within four months after granting the contract.


5. Reporting on the Knowledge Sharing Platform expera

Members

- Joint Call projects
- (Trans-)National RDD projects
- Smart Energy practitioners
- Agenda setters and policy makers

Technicalities

- Project leaders create an <u>expera expert account</u>
- If other project partners do reporting, please also register and inform <u>JPP SES partners</u> to receive reporting rights
- Invited to create your <u>project passport</u> --> visibility in Knowledge Community
- The Joint Call Secretariat will give further technical guidelines before the reporting starts





5. Reporting procedure

Projects will need to submit the following reports:

- 1. Half-year Traffic Light Report: uploaded to expera → folder will be created to which only relevant persons will have access
- 2. Mid-term report: will need to be submitted in expera, followed by a comprehensive mid-term evaluation → template for mid-term report will be ready 6 months before mid-term reporting starts
- 3. Final report: Building upon the results of the mid-term report→ shall summarize all findings and also be uploaded to expera

6. Procedure in case of deviations from the project plan

- Main Coordinator must contact
 - Joint Call Secretariat
 - National Contact Point
- Depending on the nature of the deviations:
 - Respective Country Coordinators
 - Respective Joint Call National Contact Points
 - Relevant Partners in the Joint Call -granted project must be a partner in the discussion
- Amendments to the national grant agreements shall be made, if necessary
- Template for changes will be available

7. Mid-term evaluation of term

- Midterm report submission on time
 - Submission to the expera platform
 - 6 weeks after the end of the term
- Midterm meeting planned as hybrid
 - Attendees:
 - Main Coordinator of the Joint Call-granted project
 - Work package leaders
 - Joint Call Secretariat
 - Joint Call members on a project-by-project basis.
 - Individual independent expert(s) might be invited.
 - Objectives
 - Progress and results so far
 - Planning of the remaining (then) 1 year, 2,5 months
 - Impact of the project/contribution to the acceleration of geothermal energy in Europe
 - Collaboration and coordination within the consortium
 - Dissemination activities





- August 31, 2025
- ✓ National Rules
- ✓ Final report submitted at latest 60 days after the project conclusion






